#### BIBLE STUDY

Read Luke 10:38-41.

#### BIBLE VERSE

#### TIME WITH GOD

Start this week and establish a time to sit down together and start going through this devotional. By doing this, you will be helping your child establish a pattern of reading the Bible and praying.
